*I am vehemently opposed to the Plasrefine plastic recycling plant being built in Moss Vale as proposed for the following reasons:*

- 1. Location - the location is within close proximity to residential homes, schools, churches, shopping village and importantly a rural setting with hobby farms and wineries adjacent/nearby which I feel is not an appropriate location. It will be a monstrosity and a blight on the local area.*
- 2. Traffic - according to the submission there will be approximately 100 truck movements in and out of the plant everyday impacting greatly on roads in an already choked road system. It cannot be supported by the local infrastructure.*
- 3. Air and health impacts and concerns - Plasrefine have stated that to reduce their impact from poor air quality by minimising their time spent outdoors which is a frightening statement admitting that this plant will reduce air quality.*
- 4. Water quality - it will produce 140,000 litres of waste water, loaded with microplastics, every single day. And every litre goes straight into the drinking water, the question begs how this will impact personal health from drinking this waste.*
- 6. This plant will impact on social interactions resulting from reduced air and water quality from emissions released by the facility.*
- 7. There are long-term environmental concerns caused by the pollutants from the facility.*
- 8. The local Wingecaribee council is opposed to the plant and it seems they are not being heard by the NSW government.*
