I oppose the Moss Vale Plastic Recycling facility due to health hazards of Plastic Refinery and it's toxic emissions and air pollution.

Plastic refinery uses toxic chemicals to recycle plastic products pose significant risks to human health due to the release of harmful emissions during the production process. These emissions consist of VOCs, carcinogenic substances and other toxic byproducts that can severely affect both workers and surrounding communities.

Exposure to these toxins can cause respiratory issues, headaches and nausea, while long-term exposure increases the risk of chronic diseases such as asthma, liver damage and cancer. Carcinogens like benzene are particularly dangerous being linked to leukemia and other cancers. The toxic air pollution from plastic manufacturing facilities significantly impact public health, especially in vulnerable populations like Moss Vale (resident being 200m away).

Filtration system failure will pose serious harm to Southern Highland community. It is not worth the risk and it is definitely not the right site.
