I object to the proposed plastic recycling refinery in Moss Vale on the following grounds:

Proximity risks: Residential areas (200m), ABR facility (50m), and schools (2km radius) face fire, health, and environmental hazards.

Heavy traffic increases noise, air pollution, accidents, and road degradation.

Air and water pollution risks from system failures could release hazardous toxins.

Threat to endangered species, including microbats, platypus, and vegetation habitats.

Risks to local waterways from microplastic runoff affecting drinking water sources.

High fire risks with insufficient local firefighting resources.

Negative impacts on tourism, local industries, and property values.

Long-term inefficiency of plastic recycling and environmental concerns.

Need for focus on reducing plastic waste at the source.
