Plasrefine, the proposed largest plastics burning refinery in Australia will be producing micro toxins which will be released into the air & then onto land & into the waterways, (waterways which also supply Sydney). It has long been accepted that burning plastics causes air pollution. Reports determining toxic loads, smoke and odors from the Plasrefine Factory has been requested over the past years but none has been forthcoming.

The issue of increased & ongoing traffic from trucks in & out of Moss Vale to dump at this largest refinery in Australia, is of concern to local schools & general road traffic as the location of this factory backs directly onto residential homes as well as the Government's Medical Mouse facility. Plasrefine's proposed location in Moss Vale is too close to schools, homes & the centre of this Community. I understand that on the basis of so many local objections Plasrefine was offered an alternate location by the Government which was refused.

The Southern Highlands is a rarity as it grows the most diverse range of plant species of anywhere in the world as well as supporting wildlife which will be endangered. This beauty & diversity is supported by locals and tourists through gardens, produce, viniculture, schools, restaurants & small businesses which all rely on the healthy environment & lifestyle of the area.

If Plasrefine goes ahead the quality of air, land, & water is to be subject to unending years of toxic particulates which will have far reaching effects on all levels of life while we are here & long after we have gone not just locally but in greater Australia & globally.
