The visual aspects of building such a huge facility with 14 metre high stacks

The unsuitability of the roads for the amount of heavy traffic prposed

The pollution: air, noise, water and visual that the facility will inflict on the community

Impacts to the drinking water for local and Sydney residents

The geographical unsuitability of the site being subject to the strong westerly winds prevalent in the district

The poor accuracy demonstrated in the submission eg stating that the Wingecarribee River will flow backward into the Wingecarribee

reservoir when it flows towards Sydney's main water source Warragamba Dam.

The amount of power and water the facility will use to the detriment of other local business and users.

The Plasrefine site is totally unsuitable, it will change the character of Moss Vale, Burradoo, Bowral and Mittagong.
