I am opposed to the proposed development because:

- It is too close to schools and a childcare centre. There are serious, potential risks to the children, parents and employees because of fire, explosion and failure of the water filtration process;
- the potential environmental impact of pollution from the stacks;
- removal of habitat for the endangered microbat;
- the proposed develop is too close to riparian zones;
- the potential disturbance to platypus habitat;
- the adverse impact on viticulture and agritourism;
- the proposed development is unsuitable for the Southern Highlands Innovation Park, and detrimental to the long term plan for the park;
- the fact that local fire services do not have the resources necessary to respond to a fire in the facility, which is a major risk as fires in facilities of this kind are common;
- -the chemicals in plastics are potent environmental pollutants;
- pollution will be carried by wind to Bowral, Berrima and Bundanoon;
- -the possible cost of remediation for the taxpayers of Wingecarribee;
- -the proposed facility is a misguided and economically doubtful approach to the plastic waste problem. This problem should be addressed by reducing the use of plastic in the supply chain.
