I am opposed to the proposed development because:

- It is too close to schools and a childcare centre. There are serious, potential risks to the children, parents and employees because of fire, explosion and failure of the water filtration process;*
 - the potential environmental impact of pollution from the stacks;*
 - removal of habitat for the endangered microbat;*
 - the proposed develop is too close to riparian zones;*
 - the potential disturbance to platypus habitat;*
 - the adverse impact on viticulture and agritourism;*
 - the proposed development is unsuitable for the Southern Highlands Innovation Park, and detrimental to the long term plan for the park;*
 - the fact that local fire services do not have the resources necessary to respond to a fire in the facility, which is a major risk as fires in facilities of this kind are common;*
 - the chemicals in plastics are potent environmental pollutants;*
 - pollution will be carried by wind to Bowral, Berrima and Bundanoon;*
 - the possible cost of remediation for the taxpayers of Wingecarribee;*
