I am a 7th generation Moss Valien and this year I graduated from Moss Vale agricultural high school. I do not think the proposed refinery is appropriate for this community as this is mainly a farming and tourist area. If this proposal goes through, it will greatly negatively impact on the quality of the local environment including the water and air.

I am also deeply concerned about the potential fire risk having lived through multiple fires in the area. Many people I know and love were badly affected by smoke fumes " this would be significantly worsened coming from a toxic factory.
