I am writing to express my strong objection to the recommended approval of the Plasrefine facility in Moss vale. Although I don't disagree with recycling in principle, there must be better sites for this type of facility than close to residential areas and waterways that service the community that can become polluted with devastating outcomes. After careful review of the Department of Planning and Housing and Infrastructure (DPHI) assessment, I believe there are significant failures in the evaluation process that warrant the rejection of this proposal:

- 1. High risk to humans and wildlife in the event of fire. Plastics mixed with other waste increase the risk of fire and there is a lot of flammable grass nearby.*
- 2. Increase of traffic on local roads and the ongoing monitoring of traffic levels. noise, air, dust, vibration population in residential areas.*
- 3. Plastic microplastics bleeding into the surrounding waterways and riparian zones that service the local and greater Sydney area*
