My major concerns are detailed below:

- Spills and mishandling are the main cause plastic feedstock enters the environment, ending up in stormwater systems, waterways (as noted at https://www.epa.nsw.gov.au/your-environment/litter/targeted-programs/operation-clean-sweep/prevent-plastic-feedstock-entering-the-environment)

- Transport and the number of hours each day that heavily loaded trucks will be in the area. Moss Vale is not a major 'hub' and is jam packed with cars esp at school pick up and drop off times as well as congestion in the middle of the day. This proposal will only increase traffic as well as placing a heavy burden on our roads therefore requiring even more road maintenance which is an ongoing issue now, let alone into the future

- Air quality. The release of pollutants must have some effect on individuals and the environment.

- Bush fire concerns. As experienced during the bushfires of 2019/2020 where it may be recalled there was a fire in the local Resource Recovery Centre BEFORE the main fires in the area, fires and their ramifications will continue to be an ongoing issue. A heavily laden 'plastics factory' is a 'ticking time bomb'

- Housing. As the NSW Government strategy 'is the supply and affordability of housing in Regional NSW' how will potential home buyers react to a heavy industry in a currently (predominately) lush environment.
