I strongly object to the development of the Plasrefine facility on the current proposed site in Moss Vale. This location would have a detrimental impact on the natural environment and wildlife of the Southern Highlands and the health and well-being of all residents, near and far.

The development is on Riparian land that is of a delicate ecosystem in the surrounds, which must be retained and supported for present and future generations. It is near waterways, which will pose a devastating affect to more than just the Southern Highlands water supply, far reaching to the Sydney region should something go amiss with operations, as often happens especially when stringent monitoring cannot be assured. Can the IPC members guarantee and be personally liable for future toxic hazards that approval of this proposed outlet will cause?

The social and health impact of trucks in a residential area 24/7 is totally unacceptable. This is not the appropriate or safe site for an industrial plastic processing plant, which will have unknown detrimental affects on the lives of our residents throughout the shire (air pollution) and the lifecycle and sustained growth of our native animals and vegetation. The stress is already taking its toll on residents.

Seriously, the IPC must consider as an alternative, already established industrial sites (such as Wollongong) that are requesting the facility to be developed in their established industrial areas. This would make sense and benefit all concerned, Otherwise, who on the Government Body authorising this will be willing to take the personal liability when they have been informed of the hazards that such an approval will create?

So many Southern Highland's residents are against this approval and we as a community appeal to you to ensure that it does not proceed in this inappropriate natural and residential setting.
