The development of the Plastics Recycling Facility will have a significant negative impact on the local community as well as the biotech and recreational proposals for that area.

Increased traffic movements from heavy vehicles and trucks will contribute negatively to noise and air pollution in the area. Increased road congestion on already strained roads infrastructure is also a concern.

The proposed development is in a designated bushfire prone land and fires in plastics recycling facilities have steadily been increasing over the past five years. We have limited local resources to be able to manage catastrophic fire events.

The proximity of the facility only 200m from residential areas, and in close proximity to parks, schools and childcares is an added concern.

Plastics recycling is an important issue, but an alternative location, with a larger buffer zone and one which is further away from residential areas, schools, waterways and sensitive environmental areas should be sought.

The proposal does not provide sufficient details for the public to be reassured that microplastics and other pollutants can be managed.
