*I am writing to express my strong objection to the recommended approval of the Plasrefine facility in Moss Vale. After careful review of the Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure's (DPHI) assessment, I believe there are significant failures in the evaluation process that warrant rejection of this proposal.*

- 1. Too close to residential areas (within approx 200 metres) - high risk of human, residential| and animal/wildlife loss in event of fire.*
- 2. Increased heavy vehicle traffic creating noise pollution, air pollution, dust, vibration, potential accidents, potential fatalities of wildlife, potential importation of weeds from other areas, increased degradation of roads*
- 3. Potential environmental impact of air pollution from the 'stacks' (or vents) that may be released from the ventilation system in the event of a malfunction/failure of the current air titration processes. In the event of a failure of process, these fumes could include volatile organic compounds (VOCs) or other hazardous toxins that may be harmful to health.*
