I am writing to express my strong objection to the recommended approval of the Plasrefine facility in Moss Vale. After careful review of the Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure's (DPHI) assessment, I believe there are significant failures in the evaluation process that warrant rejection of this proposal.

1) Increased heavy vehicle traffic creating noise pollution, air pollution, dust, vibration, potential accidents, potential fatalities of wildlife, potential importation of weeds from other areas, increased degradation of roads.

2)"»¿Potential environmental impact of air pollution from the 'stacks' (or vents) that may be released from the ventlation system in the event of a malfunction/failure of the current air titration processes. In the event of a failure of process, these fumes could include volatile organic compounds (VOCs) or other hazardous toxins that may be harmful to health

3)Too close to residential areas (within approx 200 metres) - high risk of human, residential | and animal/widlife loss in event of fire.
