I object to this proposal on the following grounds:  $^{st}$ 

It<sup>m</sup>s much too close to residential properties in the event there is a fire, air quality and noise pollution is unacceptable. To scope of this recycling facility being heavy industrial, has no place being this close to people<sup>m</sup>s home, schools, Day care centres and light industry businesses.

- \* This is much too close to the Garvan Institute (Bio Resources facility)ARB, vibration and noise that can effect the breeding cycle of the research mice.
- \* The increased heavy vehicle movements creating more congestion, more pollution to our air quality, increases the impacts to our roads which are already questionable.
- \* Much too close to riparian zones, which flow directly into Neighbouring properties and into the Wingecarribee River. How is that okay?? Where is the duty of care for residents and Greater Sydney and Goulburn.
