However if the construction of Plasrefine went ahead on the proposed Moss Vale site, the impact on the local community would be severely detrimental from both a social and environmental perspective.

Moss Vale is a small regional town, known for its natural beauty and commitment to preserving our green corridors. This huge construction would impact not only the landscape but the air quality (both in terms of micro plastics that could be released into the air but also added pollution from trucks operating 24/7), water quality due to poisonous plastic runoff, noise pollution and safety, with large trucks operating 24/7 through the small town.
