This development is not appropriate for the chosen site. As a community member I'm shocked and dismayed that this is looking close to being approved. The Southern Highlands roads are already at capacity (try getting through Moss Vale at school drop off). I'm concerned about the impact to the environment and the health of myself and my family. We had been considering a move from another village in to Moss Vale and we no longer feel that's a good idea - there will be others who feel the same and those wanting to get out of Moss Vale before there properties are unsellable. We're in the middle of a housing crisis and now this added pressure. I'd like to see the Government and other large businesses putting their energy, time and money into reducing plastic consumption - recycling like this facility, is not actually treating the root source. Lastly, my daughter attended childcare on the same street and I have my youngest daughter on the waitlist for the centre on [REDACTED]. I can no longer consider this as an option. Waitlists for childcare in the Highlands is 2-3 years long. An approval of the development here removes one more childcare option for me and hundreds of other families. It's looking likely that I will not be able to return to work without childcare. Has this even been taken into consideration?
