I strongly oppose this development.

Human Rights Watch research has found that plastic recycling facility workers and nearby communities can be exposed to harmful chemicals when they inhale toxic dust or fumes emitted during the recycling process, which threatens their right to health. This exposure to air pollution puts communities at the risk of developing significant life-long health conditions, including cancer and reproductive system harms.

The fact this is proposed to be developed in a major town in the Southern Highlands, as well as in close proximity to schools and day cares is inhumane.

As well as the toxicity that will come with this development, the increased traffic on local and suburban road - past our schools and daycare - is concerning.
