I am a strong supporter of waste reduction, recycling and the circular economy. I grow my own food, choose plastic free where possible, and recycle everything.

I am also a resident of Moss Vale and strongly object to this development.

This proposal by Plasrefine would be disastrous for our small community on many levels. And I urge the commission to reject the application.

As noted by Wingecarribee Shire Council, this development is:

- Inconsistent with the adopted Moss Vale Enterprise Corridor Development Control Plan and emerging strategic masterplanning work on the Southern Highlands Innovation Park
- provides inadequate water and sewer infrastructure
- lacks provision of transport infrastructure
- does not address community health and amenity concerns, and
- lacks a Social Impact Statement.

Plasrefine has done nothing to build trust with the community. As documented by the Sydney Morning Herald, companies owned by have been censured by ****'s Environmental and Ecological Bureau. Public notices on the bureau's website show four regulatory infractions from 2011, including air pollution.

I hold grave concerns not only for the broader community, but for residents adjoining the site. Noise during construction, ongoing air, land and water pollution, 24/7 traffic movements and reduced visual amenity will all be significant.

This is NOT THE RIGHT SITE.
