Dear Planning Officer,

I am writing to formally object to the proposed Plasrefine Recycling facility, a 24/7 plastics reprocessing operation, slated for development in Moss Vale. While I recognise the importance of recycling and responsible waste management, I have serious concerns about the potential environmental, health, and community impacts of this facility.

Operating continuously, this facility is likely to increase noise and light pollution, which will disrupt the quiet residential environment that Moss Vale residents value. Additionally, the risk of chemical emissions and potential hazards from processing plastic materials poses an environmental threat, potentially impacting air and water quality in the surrounding area. The facility's close proximity to local residences and natural areas amplifies these concerns, particularly in terms of its impact on local wildlife and community health.

Given these concerns, I urge the council to reconsider the approval of this development in its current form. Surely an alternative site could be found closer to the primary source of the waste being processed (thus reducing freight time/cost/emissions) or a site in an area with less community/natural impact.
