# Southern Highlands Threatened Species - Fauna



The Southern Highlands is home to an incredible variety of fauna species. Due to historic and current threats, several of these species are threatened under either the NSW *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016* or the Federal *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999*.

Below is a list of the threatened fauna species found within the Southern Highlands. This list was exported from BioNet (2024). It is important to note, threatened species have associations with Plant Community Types (PCTs), meaning there could be other threatened fauna species in the region that are associated with local PCTs that are not listed below.

Overtime, species currently not listed as threatened, may be added to this list as well.
