To whom it may concern,

As a nearby resident I have both concerns regarding increased traffic volumes, potential airbourne microplastics and future fire hazards.

I live within a close radius of the Wingecarribee Resource Recovery Centre, which caught fire briefly during the 2019-20 Bush fires, resulting in ember fall out on my property. If the the proposed plastics facilty was to catch fire at a later point, I imagine that somekind of similar ember fallout could reach my neighbourhood. I am also concerned about my health and the idea that microplastics may be present in the surrounding atmosphere/environment is distressing. Additionally I already experience heavy truck traffic flow near my home and believe that further heavy traffic flow would cause increased noise and hazards for pedestrians, including children on bikes etc.
