Hi, I think the site is not the right location due to the environmental impact it will cause with development being on good farm land and also potentially affecting surrounding farms with livestock and hay. I also believe it will compromise the ground water with micro plastics and chemical runoff, our groundwater which is extensively used throughout the highlands is precious to a lot of farms and livestock producers (Similarly to the Hume coal project being unsuitable due to the impact on groundwater i believe that this should be more thoroughly assessed). Furthermore I believe that the production of large scale plastics will diminish our air quality in our otherwise great neighbourhood with residential areas only meters away and schools within only a few kilometres. Additionally traffic is already over-encumbered in Moss Vale, I believe if this must go ahead here a more suitable position would be the vacant land on lackey road Moss Vale industrial area which has rail access via berrima junction next door to Omya. As an employee of the rail sector I can say that Veolia have been taking containerised rubbish out of Sydney to Tarrago for 20 years, it has considerably reduced trucks noise pollution and traffic in that area, keeping in mind 50 rail wagons would be equivalent to 100 b-double trucks.
