A 11.	 The Application proposes loading/dispatch of trucks from 6am – 10pm. Amenity impacts have been assessed based on this timeframe. No predicted amenity exceedances in the Department's assessment with 6am start. Any change to 7am does appear to benefit any nearby receivers given existing traffic on Pacific Highway. 	 Intent is to minimise potential impacts of trucks arriving to site earlier in the morning to nearby receivers. Also enables the staggering of start times in relation to other quarry activities in the area.

B38. (to become B40.)	 Would be ideal, but potentially not workable given it is a commercial quarry. The quarry vehicles are likely to be owned and run 	Contracts with haulage contractors could stipulate conditions, including those relating to the vehicles
