*I want to express my family's deep concerns and strong opposition to the proposed stone ridge quarry project. Our family has lived here for 6 generations and 5 generations now and my ninety four year old mother in-law whom lives [REDACTED] represents the eldest generation. This land holds a legacy for us and we've built our lives here with deep commitment to our community. We already live with the effects of an existing quarry nearby that wants to expand, the dust the noise, relentless truck traffic have affected our lives in ways that are hard to ignore, adding a new quarry would only worsen these issues making our daily environment even less liveable. The dust from the current quarry impacts air quality which is especially concerning for all residents especially the elderly and people with respiratory conditions. Noise from trucks disrupts the peace we deserve in our own homes, the heavy traffic along our road creates safety concerns that impact everyone who lives here. Additionally this project threatens the value of our land which has been in our family for generations, the presence of an additional industrial quarry so close to our property will likely reduce its value significantly compromising our family's long term investment and the worth of everything we have built here. For those of us closest to the quarry this is a real and lasting impact on our financial wellbeing. Finally we are concerned about potential environmental impact and damage, mining activities could jeopardise water quality and disrupt the ecosystem, while the increased dust and noise will continue to erode our quality of life. The natural beauty and integrity have already been impacted and the stone ridge quarry project threatens to push those boundaries even further.*

*In summary we are firmly opposed to this project, expanding quarry operations here would not only harm our family and reduce the value of our property but it will also diminish the quality of life for our entire community, we urge those in charge of this decision to carefully consider the long term impact on all residents, please consider the real consequences of this proposal on the lives of those closest to it*
