



<p>Nundle – commencement Opening statement by Panel Chair, introductions, and short overview of locality tour.</p> <p>1) Chaffey Dam lookout Travelled north along Nundle Road to Chaffey Dam. Observed Chaffey Dam and outlook south towards site from Chaffey Dam lookout.</p> <p>2) Lindsays Gap Road and Nundle Road intersection Stopped at the intersection and observed the surrounds and outlook to the south and east towards the site.</p> <p>3) Innes Street, Nundle Stopped along Innes Street to observe the areas proposed for widening and tree removal. Observed road diagrams prepared by the Applicant (published on the Commission's website).</p> <p>4) Teamsters Rest campsite Stopped at the Teamsters Rest campsite; observed the surrounding area and outlook towards the site. On the way to travelling to the next location, the Panel visited ENGIE's Nundle community drop-in location to view the project model on display.</p> <p>5) Barry Road Observed the land slip located on Barry Road.</p>
